Label the page Work Cited in the center and at the top of the page	
Double space all citations, but do not skip space between entries	
Write your work cited page on a separate page at the end of your	
research paper. It should have 1-inch margins.	
Indent the second and following lines of citations so that you have a hanging indent.	
Capitalize each word in the title of articles, books, etc. But do not

the first word of the title or subtitle: The Art of War	
Use italics (instead of underlining) for title or larger works (books,	
magazines) and quotation marks for titles of shorter works (poems,
